Shalom! I am writing this newsletter as the newly elected President of the MJAA. It is humbling to be in the position of leadership of an organisation that was established in 1927, 96 years ago! I thank the Lord and the MJAA committee for the opportunity to serve in this role.

It has been a joy to serve as Secretary and now I hand over this role to our new committee member, Ashley Crane, a Bible scholar and teacher with an international teaching ministry. Our previous President, Brad Burman, is taking the role of Vice President and his wife, Helen, continues to serve capably as Treasurer and artist, co-directing the Messianic Jewish Art Forum.

Kon Michailidis continues to serve as an Ordinary member, bringing wisdom, experience and clarity to our decision-making processes.

I also thank our members and friends for their ongoing prayers and support. While we may be a small group in Australia, we are part of a big international family as members of the International Messianic Jewish Alliance (IMJA) who encourage and pray for us as we grow in the local ministry "down under".

Attending the IMJA conference in Israel from 8-12 October this year with Brad and Helen brought home that sense of family connection with Messianic believers from the many member nations of the IMJA. We became aware of possibilities for collaborating on international projects in future.

I can let you know that we are looking into an Australian partnership with the Joseph Project, a humanitarian aid organisation set up and run by the Messianic Jewish Alliance of America. The Joseph Project makes an exceptional impact by sending containers of medical and other supplies for distribution across the whole of Israel. Our expanding membership base has also been encouraging and our prayer is to see this increase. As we continue to grow, we meet many Jewish believers in Yeshua, as well as Messianic Christians who are isolated from a community that supports Israel and understands its prophetic relationship with the Church.

Sadly, we still see many of our brothers and sisters in the Lord who have adopted supersessionism (replacement theology), the erroneous message that the church has replaced Israel in God's plan, a belief that fosters hatred and resentment towards Jewish people, providing a fertile field for antisemitism to grow. We know that through prayer this can change and people's understanding can be opened to God's purpose in uniting Jews and Gentiles as "one new person" (NASB) through faith in the atoning work of Yeshua (Ephesians 2:15).

Our goal is to network with Jewish and Christian Messianic believers for prayer, fellowship, teaching and outreach, demonstrating our connectedness in the body of Messiah.

We have been blessed to link up with the Love Israel ministry this year and participate in their conference in Sydney in September. We look forward to a continued relationship in promoting each other's work and we welcome co-operation with other Messianic ministries too.

Wishing you all a Happy Hanukkah, the Festival of Lights, where Yeshua declared Himself to be "the light of the world" (John 8:12). Traditional Hanukkah foods including *sufganiyot* (doughnuts) and *latkes* (potato fritters) remind us of the oil that kept the temple light burning at the first Hanukkah. This also reminds us of God's promise to pour out the Holy Spirit on all flesh in the last days (Joel 2:28).

We trust that you will keep upholding Israel in prayer, for release of all hostages, for protection and mercy for all innocent people caught in the war, and for the light of Yeshua to be revealed in a powerful way to all involved.

It is an irony that at the first Hanukkah it was *Haman* who sought to annihilate Israel; now it is *Hamas*. As we watch history repeating itself, Psalm 83:4, written about 3000 years ago, reads like today's newspaper, with antisemitic voices saying: "Come, let us destroy them as a nation, so that Israel's name is remembered no more." In the midst of this, we stand on the secure knowledge that the covenant of the God of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob will never fail. His love endures forever.

MEMBERSHIP

The MJAA is a membership organisation which aims to unite Jewish and Gentile believers in fellowship and mutual support. We welcome members from all Australian locations and congregations. We are affiliated with the International Messianic Jewish Alliance, which has chapters in 16 nations. If you would like to join us, please go to mjaa.org.au/membership for more information. A summary of the rules of membership from our constitution is below:

1. A person is eligible to be a member of the MJAA if they are:

- (a) a natural person (a human being) who is at least eighteen years of age
- (b) a citizen or permanent resident of Australia
- (c) in agreement with the Aims and Statement of Belief and has expressed this in a written declaration or equivalent
- (d) has been nominated for membership of the association as provided by clauses 4-7
- (e) have paid their membership fee for the current year (or had their fee waived by the management committee) see clauses 14-17.

2. Membership is divided into two categories being membership (voting) and membership (ordinary):

- (a) A member (voting) is a person also who has, or had, at least one parent or grandparent who is identifiably Jewish or is the current husband, wife or child of a member
- (b) Membership (ordinary) is open to any person who supports our aims as in Point 1 (c) above.

Testimony

One of our members shared this testimony after attending Dr Ashley Crane's online seminar titled "A Brief History of Antisemitism." The seminar was hosted by Rabbi Larry Greenhaus from Keren Ohr Messianic Synagogue in Bloomingdale, Georgia (USA).

Many thanks for granting me the opportunity to attend this excellent seminar. Personally, I am deeply ashamed of the so-called Christian Churches' history of hatred against God's chosen people. Having been born in South Africa and raised in the Reformed Church I could never understand the logic behind replacement theology and antisemitism. My upbringing as a farmer's son never made provision for such nonsense.

All my life, since about the age of 6, I was blessed with Jewish friends. The last friend I had when leaving South Africa was an elderly lady, who never became a Christian and told me many times to treat Christians with caution, because of their intense hatred of the Jews.

Here in Australia, I "automatically" joined the Reformed Church of Australia. What a shock to discover that the pastor and his elders were 100% antisemitic. I was criticised for being a student of the Israel Study Centre, which was a wonderful and fruitful time of my life when I gained excellent insight into Jewish insights into scriptures. As a result of this I could no longer tolerate the Satan inspired influence of the Reformed Church and tendered my resignation. I am grateful that our LORD led me to the Messianic Jewish Alliance of Australia and pray for His blessing on the good work you do in His Name.
